**Open Forum**

-CCGC would like to plan more of their events around educating and training GSR's and the fellowship in general. They would like to have 4 workshops a year and focus on IP topics, Steps, Traditions, etc. They will be implementing these workshops into their fun events. They would like the support from the whole area as it is felt there is a divide between Cedar and St. George. The reason for the divide was discussed as years ago CCGC was created for Cedar to be their own area. Ways to help rectify the divide were discussed such as planning events together, not scheduling events on top of each other, teaming up on the campout, and making sure GSRs are taking CCGC's event information back to their groups. Anyone can be a member of CCGC.

-If people are not on social media how are we getting the word out about events and other important area information? PR and RCM are going to look into doing text alerts for meeting changes and events.

-Mobile Meetings from region were discussed. Many groups wanted more information and others did not take it back to their groups. RCM needed a vote done about how our area felt about it before region on the 17th so the GSRs made the decision here after the discussion. It was felt that since they will not be showing up for our area and our 7th tradition will be helping to fund them, and in general GSRs do not see a need for this to become its own committee we do not support Mobile meetings as its own Regional Committee.

-The Southern Utah men's retreat was a success and they will be making a \$100 area donation.

-There will be a Southern Utah Women's retreat in 2024 sponsored by Ladies First Home Group. It will be May 17-19 2024 in Pine Valley. The first business meeting will be Sunday, September 17th at 12:35 after the women's meeting.

-Storage Unit ADHOC sat down with policy and put together the guidelines for the storage unit position. Guidelines and procedures happen first. When groups are voting now they are voting for it to be a new position with these guidelines. If they pass and it becomes a new position under the executive body the person then voted in will be a non-voting member. If it passes we will be set next month to vote someone in. Guidelines below:

## Narcotics Anonymous of Southern Utah

### Storage Facility Guidelines

### Guidelines and Procedures

#### Article I. Definition and Purpose

The Storage Facility Position of Narcotics Anonymous is a position of the Area Executive body

of the Narcotics Anonymous of Southern Utah Area Service Committee (ASC.) It is housed in

the Area Executive body of the ASC, as a non-voting member. It is made up of volunteer

members from Narcotics Anonymous groups specifically for the fellowship. The primary

objective of the storage facility coordinator is to maintain a clean and well-organized storage

shed throughout the year.

#### Article II. Duties and Responsibilities

### Post-Event Procedures

After each event, ensure that all borrowed items are promptly returned to their

designated storage locations. Additionally, dispose of any perishable items or opened products.

#### Sign-In and Out Process

Implement a sign-in and out sheet for all activity personnel to complete after each

event.

#### Quarterly Inventory

Conduct a thorough inventory of all storage items on a quarterly basis, specifically in

the months of May, August, November, and February. During this time, also dedicate

efforts to clean the storage floor.

#### Safety Considerations

For items utilizing gas or other flammable products, prioritize their secure storage.

Furthermore, assume responsibility for the maintenance of such equipment

#### Combination Locks

Change the combination locks on storage units annually, ideally within two months of

the election period.

#### High-Value Items

Items valued at \$100 or more should be securely locked and secured separately.

#### SUACNA Banners

Ensure that all SUACNA banners returning from conventions are properly stored in

storage tubes.



Article III. Positions and Duties

All candidates for elected office must meet the qualifications stipulated in these guidelines. An

officer may resign at any time. Officers may succeed themselves by reelection only one time.

Nominations for officer positions will take place in February of each year. Requirements and

qualifications for the positions are as follows: (Minimum of years clean):

Storage Facility Guidelines Created 9/23

I. Chairperson.....Two years clean/Two-year position

II. Co-Chairperson..... Two years clean /One-year position

Willingness to give the time and resources.

Reliable transportation is recommended.

Active participation in Narcotics Anonymous.

CHAIRPERSON RESPONSIBILITIES Two (2) years clean time.

Working knowledge of the Twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions, and Twelve Concepts of

Narcotics Anonymous.

Keeps informed of the activities of the sub-committees, and be aware when/if events

conflict with other NASU events.

Executes judgment without giving personal options.

Because the Chair is a position in the Executive body Narcotics Anonymous of Southern

Utah Area, the Chair should not sit on the Executive Committee of ASC, to

avoid

spiritual conflict.

Brings written report to Area.

CO-CHAIRPERSON RESPONSIBILITIES One (1) year clean time.

Working knowledge of the Twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions, and Twelve Concepts of

Narcotics Anonymous.

Will act as Chair when the Chairperson is not available.

Works closely with Chairperson to share responsibilities for the area.

Co-chair attends Area if Chair is unable to attend.

#### Article IV. Removal of an Officer

If an officer does not fulfill duties required as described in Article III, that member will be notified

in writing of the meeting at which removal from office will be discussed and voted upon. At that

meeting, the Member may present statements to the ASC body in an effort to retain the position.

Removal will occur if so voted by majority of the Members present at the meeting.

Any Elected Member who fails to attend TWO of the last THREE regular ASC meetings

without being excused by the Presiding Member from attending, will be considered for

removal.

Relapse is grounds for automatic removal from the position

#### Article V. Annual Accounting

Each calendar year, a full and complete account of the condition of the Subcommittee

shall be made to the Members. The annual accounting shall take place at the

## Annual

Meeting for the preceding year.

All financial transactions shall be reviewed annually by a Subcommittee Audit Committee

in conjunction with the ASC Treasurer.

-Area goes smoother when everyone is in the same room. If we choose to go to CBDM it's all about the discussion and if GSRs or ALTs are not here they are not able to take the information back to their groups that is needed. To get the unity back and have the discussion the way CBDM is supposed to be a discussion was had about removing Zoom and going back to all area business meetings being in person. We don't want to limit participation or people getting their voice heard so extenuating circumstances may still be able to Zoom, possibly by RSVPing for Zoom and getting the code from the secretary. A proposal was made to be in person with no Zoom for 3 months.

- GSR training was discussed. One main training a year with quarterly refreshers. RCM and Outreach have done it in the past. It is in no one's guidelines. At this time anyone who feels strongly about GSR training can help RCM put together training. ## GUIDELINES FOR STORAGE FACILITATOR

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efforts to clean the storage floor.

#### Safety Considerations

For items utilizing gas or other flammable products, prioritize their secure storage.

Furthermore, assume responsibility for the maintenance of such equipment

#### Combination Locks

Change the combination locks on storage units annually, ideally within two months of

the election period.

#### High-Value Items

Items valued at \$100 or more should be securely locked and secured separately.

#### SUACNA Banners

Ensure that all SUACNA banners returning from conventions are properly stored in

storage tubes.

#### Article III. Positions and Duties

All candidates for elected office must meet the qualifications stipulated in these guidelines. An

officer may resign at any time. Officers may succeed themselves by reelection only one time.

Nominations for officer positions will take place in February of each year. Requirements and

qualifications for the positions are as follows: (Minimum of years clean):

Executes judgment without giving personal options.

Because the Chair is a position in the Executive body Narcotics Anonymous of Southern

Utah Area, the Chair should not sit on the Executive Committee of ASC, to avoid

spiritual conflict.

Brings written report to Area.

CO-CHAIRPERSON RESPONSIBILITIES One (1) year clean time.

Working knowledge of the Twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions, and Twelve Concepts of

Narcotics Anonymous.

Will act as Chair when the Chairperson is not available.

Works closely with Chairperson to share responsibilities for the area.

Co-chair attends Area if Chair is unable to attend.

#### Article IV. Removal of an Officer

If an officer does not fulfill duties required as described in Article III, that member will be notified

in writing of the meeting at which removal from office will be discussed and voted upon. At that

meeting, the Member may present statements to the ASC body in an effort to retain the position.

Removal will occur if so voted by majority of the Members present at the meeting.

Any Elected Member who fails to attend TWO of the last THREE regular ASC meetings

without being excused by the Presiding Member from attending, will be considered for

removal.

Relapse is grounds for automatic removal from the position

#### Article V. Annual Accounting

Each calendar year, a full and complete account of the condition of the Subcommittee

shall be made to the Members. The annual accounting shall take place at the Annual



Meeting for the preceding year.

All financial transactions shall be reviewed annually by a Subcommittee Audit Committee

in conjunction with the ASC Treasurer.
